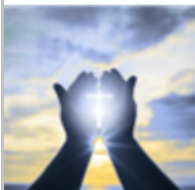

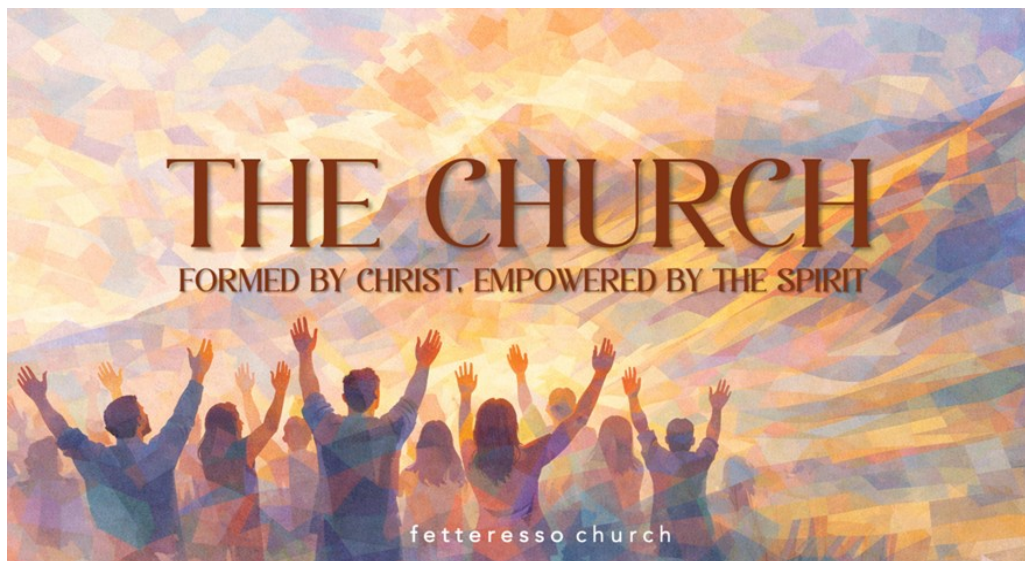

As we begin this new sermon series on the church, we do so anchored in the words of the apostle Paul:

“So, then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone.” Ephesians 2:19–20

This series is an invitation, not just to attend, but to belong; not just to listen, but to be built together. God has not called us to follow Christ in isolation, but to be formed as His people, joined together around Jesus Christ, our cornerstone. We are the church.

That’s why I’m encouraging everyone to take part fully in this journey. Alongside the preaching on Sundays, our home groups have been equipped to study through this series, so that God’s Word can shape us in different places: around our kitchen tables, in prayer, in honest conversation, and in shared obedience.
