Then he said to them all, 'If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will save it.....

Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.....

Then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!' Luke 9:23, 24, 28-31,35.

Last month in our prayer focus we concentrated on Hope. Lately in our Sunday worship we have been studying the children of Israel as they were led by Moses out of captivity and slavery in Egypt through the desert to the promised land. The first Exodus. As we enter March we come to Transfiguration Sunday, when Jesus met with Moses and Elijah on the mountain top. Jesus in this encounter was being prepared for his death and his departure from earth.
