


# Welcome to Stonehaven Fetteresso

## PARKING AT CHURCH

The bible teaches us to love our neighbours as ourselves and whilst parking may not have been at the forefront of the authors mind when writing it, we are asking that you consider this verse (Mark 12 v 31) in all possible contexts...including parking your car.

**L**eave clear space and do not park across or very close to our neighbours driveways or the church entrance.

**O**bserve the views of emerging vehicles and keep sightlines open.

**V**ehicles should not park on corners of roads e.g Kirk Road / Bath Street corner

**E**nsure you follow the Highway Code at all times.

As always if you are disbaled or have restricted mobility you can park on the east side of the church drive.
